GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION

WHERE YOUR MEMBERSHIP FEES GO

Your full membership fee is paid out as follows:

- \$65: \$45 AGA/\$25 PMGC (note: AGA fee is \$40 for online renewals)
- \$50 If dues paid from July 1 Sept 30: \$25 AGA/\$25 PMGC
- AGA dues include USGA handicap and GHIN #

PMGC dues includes \$2 going to a hole-in-one fund for the calendar year. All members with hole-in-ones will split the pot for the calendar year.

Social Member - \$25 to PMGC (Do not use online AGA registration)

• Social members can participate in club social functions, club membership meetings and have voting privileges.

Social members are not eligible to participate in any PMGC golfing events.

WEEKLY GAMES

Low Gross/Low Net game is played each week when there is not a special event game scheduled. \$2.00 sweeps payment is collected from each player, by the pro shop starter, when you check-in and pay your golf fees.

Special event games have \$5.00 or \$10.00 entry fee. Games that are played over multiple weeks require a cash payment in advance the week prior to the first week of the event. These games will pay winnings in cash.

Special events are scheduled for 2 weeks a month (i.e. Scramble, Best Ball, etc.) and a two-week game is scheduled to coincide with the PGA major tournaments. Game rules

are posted on the PB Men's Golf bulletin board, the club website, and a copy is provided for each team in their pouch on the day of play.

Other special events include:

- Match Play Championship in February
- Medal Play Championship in March
- THE Club Championship, played over one weekend in March. This is a gross score only tournament, played from the BLUE tees, with the winner representing PMGC in the SCW championship.

All games are pre-flighted by tee played and handicap. Flights may vary in size due to the natural cut between handicaps.

There are also a couple free beverage days throughout the year and two club BBQ days, one in the spring and one in the fall.

Handicaps are updated weekly on Tuesdays prior to league play.

PAYOUTS

Prize money for the winners of LOW GROSS/LOW NET games are paid to the member's RCSCW account as TOURNAMENT WINNINGS. Your balance appears as a line item on pro shop receipts.

Special event games payout prize money in cash.

HOW TO SIGN UP TO PLAY IN EVENTS

Fill out the weekly signup slip, available on Wednesday, for the upcoming week. The signup sheet allows you to register for play for the following Wednesday. Please legibly write in your name, rec. # and circle tee time desired. Extra copies are at the monitor table.

OR...

Email monitor at pbmensgolf@gmail.com if you were not able to sign up on Wednesday after play.

CANCELLING YOUR ASSIGNED TEE TIME

Email the monitor **by 1:00 pm on the Tuesday** prior to league play.

DO NOT CALL THE GOLF SHOP TO CANCEL. YOU MUST GO THROUGH THE MONITOR.

TEE TIME FORMATS

Shotgun Start - Groups have hole assignments and all tee off at the same time.

• Players may choose to play the morning or afternoon shotgun. Shotgun starts typically run from November thru late April/early May.

Straight Sheet - Tee time assignments beginning when course opens, then every 7 or 8 minutes.

• Straight tee times typically run from May through mid/late October

TEE ASSIGNMENT

WHITE tees are the default. Players with an index of 19.5 (this is a 15 handicap from gold tees) or higher may request to play from the GOLD tees. Players with an index of 27.0 or more may request to play from the GREEN tees. (Green tee requests can also be submitted to our monitor to review on an individual basis) Once you designate to play the GOLD or GREEN tees, you must play from that tee **as long as you are eligible** for the remainder of the calendar time frame. You may request to change your tee designation twice a year; July 1 and January 1. If your index drops below the target index, you will be reassigned to the next tee back (green to gold, gold to white).

GAME DAYS

When arriving to play on game days, report to the monitor's table to verify your starting assignment and if you choose, sign up to participate in the BLIND BOGEY. Sign up at the monitor's table to participate. The cost is \$1.00. If your net score matches the number drawn, you share the pot with all players with the winning score. This is a cash prize. **Blind Bogey is an optional game.**

At the monitor's table each group pairing will have a pouch. The designated captain is in charge of the pouch. The weekly captain is designated on the weekly tee sheet posted on the club website and also at the monitor's table on the day of play. The Captain records scores, **obtains all signatures on scorecard,** fills out sign up slip for coming week, collects \$2 monitor fee from each member (or guest), turns in completed pouch to monitor's table after the round. The completed pouch should contain \$2 per player, **completed signed scorecard** and completed sign up sheet for the next week if applicable.

PB Men's club posts Wednesday's scores. For USGA handicap purposes, members are required to maintain an accurate handicap. Scores may be posted on the AGA website or on your GHIN app or website. When you play in a Pebblebrook sanctioned event, your score will be posted by the Pebblebrook monitor.

CLUB INFORMATION

CLUB WEB PAGE: pbmensgolf.scwclubs.com. The site contains:

- Tee times and pairings for coming Wednesday.
- Winners from previous Wednesday including Blind Bogey
- A yearly list of all events/tournaments
- What's coming up for the next 4 weeks, including event flyers explaining the event.
- Membership and other club related information

AND much more. Please get used to referring to the site as it's where you will find all up-to-date club information.

There is also a bulletin board right outside the pro shop with information concerning upcoming events and results from the previous week's game.

CLUB QUARTERLY MEETINGS

We hold two club membership meetings per year. There is discussion of club business, as well as food and drinks, door prizes, speakers and 50/50 drawing.

MISCELLANEOUS

Participants in PMGC will abide by the USGA, AGA and SCW local rules when participating in our club events.

Local rules can be found on the club website as well as bulletin board in men's room and the back of the Pebblebrook scorecards.

Course Maintenance – 'ADOPT-a-HOLE' (AAH) Program: In addition to the usual repair of ballmarks and divots, the PMGC's 'Adopt-a-Hole' program assigns each player a hole, that will permanently be his 'adopted hole' during his duration with the club. The member will do additional clean up on his AAH during Wednesday play, such as filling more divots than your own, fixing any ball marks you see on the green, picking up any broken tees or garbage you may see. Your 'adopted' hole number will appear on the Wednesday scorecard, next to your name. More info on this 'Adopt-a-Hole' program can be found on the club website.

Putting out is mandatory. NO GIMMES. Failure to putt out results in a WD.

Game day handicaps are updated on the day preceding club play. Multiple week events lock into the player's handicap on the first day of the event.
